



VOLUNTEER AT THE ADELAIDE FESTIVAL CENTRE

Volunteers at the AFCT play a key role in the success of the Adelaide Festival Centre. This group of people – who come from all walks of life and boast very diverse backgrounds – are united in two key ways: they all have a passion for the arts and have an unwavering commitment to helping the AFCT achieve its mission:

- To be the heart of the Festival State
- To be the best Arts Centre in the country

There are many volunteering opportunities at the AFCT which are suited to people with different time commitments.

- **Tours of the Centre** on Tuesday and Thursday mornings at 11am - tour training is provided - duration of the tour shift is approx 3 hours commencing at 10am for pre-tour check
- **Concierge Desk** in Festival Theatre– meet and greet - Monday to Friday 10am to 1pm or 1pm to 4pm - office support, computer skills, mail outs, data entry, packing artist bags for various festivals, entering surveys onto the computer etc
- **Flyer Distribution** as part of the Concierge Desk role.
- **Information Booth - Festival Theatre** – meet and greet - when we have a performance the Info Booth opens 1 hour 30mins prior to the performance commencing i.e. 8pm performance start time the shift in the Info Booth is 6.30pm to 8pm
- **Artspace** – meet and greet – when we have a performance in the Dunstan Playhouse or Space The Artspace is opened 1 hour prior for patrons to view the exhibition
- Volunteers also help at **Special Events** i.e. the Guitar Festival, OzAsia Festival, events in Elder Park, Festival of Arts

The commitment the AFC would be looking for is one shift per week when necessary for a period of twelve months. Of course our needs in the Information Booth depend on performance schedules so this roster can vary.
