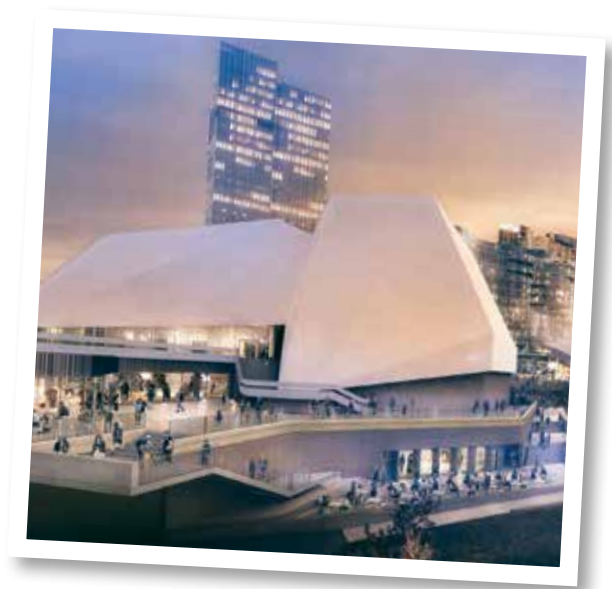




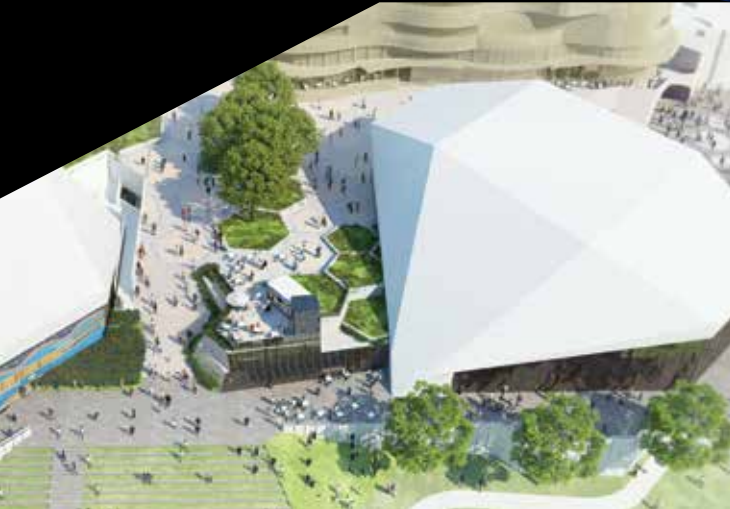
ADELAIDE'S OWN WALK OF FAME

As part of the redevelopment, Adelaide Festival Centre will create a Walk of Fame to act as an east-west promenade along the River Torrens side of the venue. This will provide pedestrian access to new entries to the Dunstan Playhouse and the Festival Theatre. In a celebration of Festival Centre's cultural heritage, the Walk of Fame will feature three artists who have performed at Festival Centre venues for each and every year since its doors first opened in 1973.



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FESTIVAL THEATRE

As part of the redevelopment, the Festival Theatre and its foyer will close for five months from 23 July 2017 to 26 December 2017. Other Adelaide Festival Centre venues, including Dunstan Playhouse, Space Theatre, Artspace Gallery and Her Majesty's Theatre (Grote Street) will all remain open during this period.

The current redevelopment is the most significant capital infrastructure project undertaken since our doors opened in 1973.

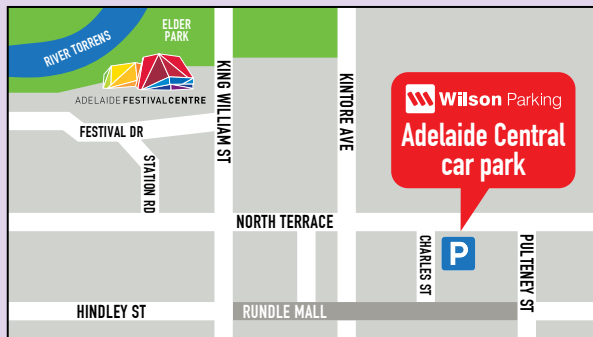
CAR PARKING

We have partnered with Wilson Parking to offer patrons discounted parking at Wilson Adelaide Central (225 North Terrace) car park.

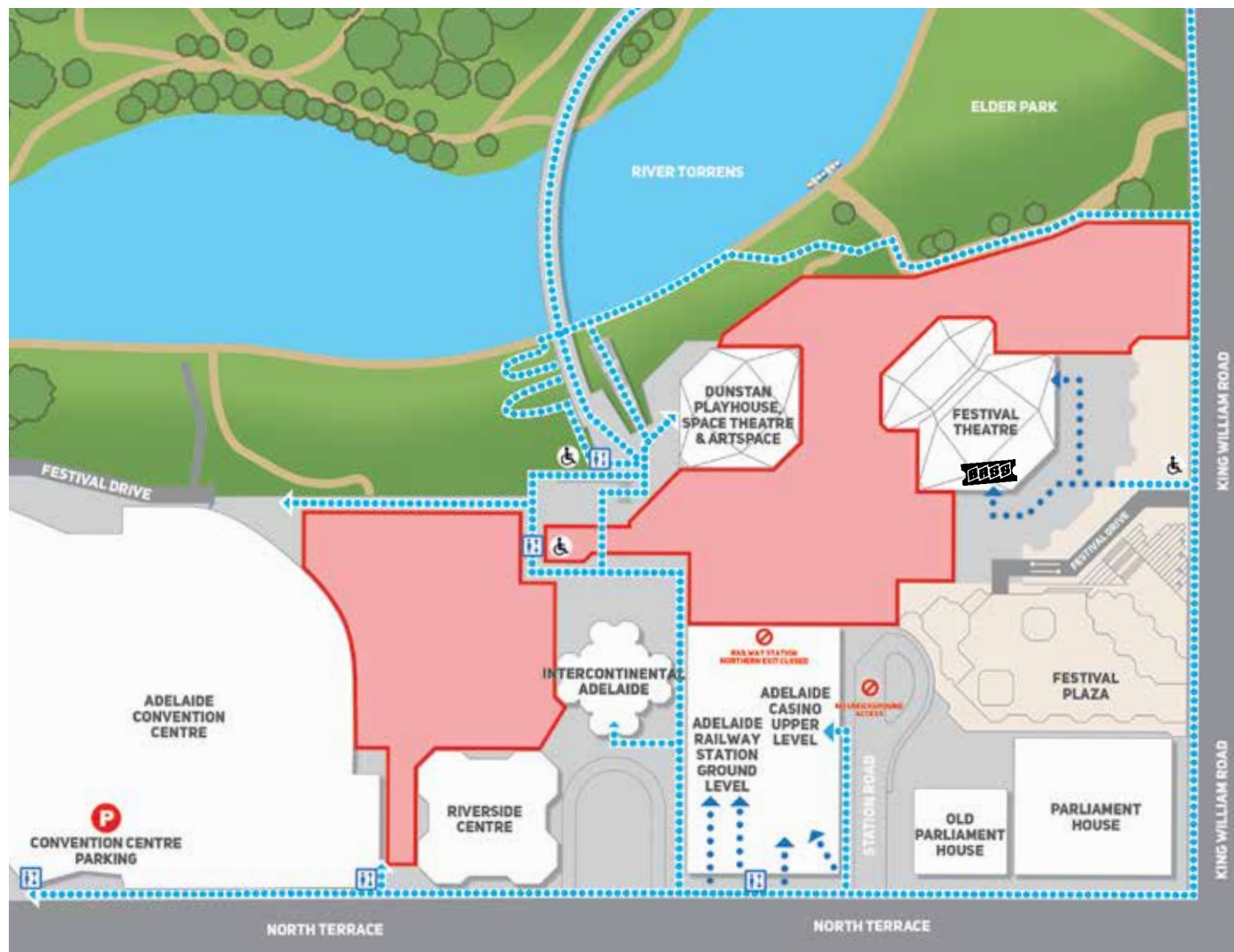

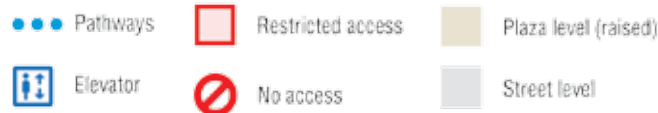


VENUE ACCESS from December 6
