

# OVERVIEW



Adelaide Festival Centre, Australia's first multi-purpose arts centre, was built in 1973. The Festival Centre is centrally located approximately 50 metres north of the corner of North Terrace and King William Street, lying near the banks of the River Torrens and adjacent to Elder Park. It is distinguished by its three silvery-white geometric dome roofs and its plaza.







# VENUES



**DUNSTAN PLAYHOUSE** is a more intimate venue, seating 590 people across two levels. State Theatre of South Australia has been based here since 1974 and uses the theatre, the rehearsal rooms and the extensive production workshop housed in this second 'white shell'.

**SPACE THEATRE** is an extremely versatile studio theatre with no traditional stage or fixed seating. It can be transformed into a theatre in the round, a corner stage setting or a cabaret venue and depending on configuration seats anywhere between 200 to 350 people.

**HER MAJESTY'S THEATRE** (Grote Street) was built in 1913 and originally called The Tivoli which set the tone for the theatre's colourful role in Adelaide's theatre history. Her Majesty's Theatre seats 1009 people and is located at 58 Grote Street, Adelaide.

**THE ARTSPACE GALLERY** situated above the Dunstan Playhouse at Adelaide Festival Centre offers a year round curated program of exhibitions. This dramatic, natural-light-filled gallery can also be completely blacked out and allows for a diverse range of exhibitions.

## **THE RIVER DECK**

The recently completed scenic deck, overlooking the River Torrens, Elder Park and Adelaide Oval, offers an outdoor or enclosed marquee function space with a capacity of up to 120 people cocktail style.

**FESTIVAL THEATRE** is the largest proscenium arch theatre in Adelaide, seating close to 2000 people. It was designed as both a lyric theatre and concert hall, and is used not only for theatrical productions and large concerts, but also for graduation ceremonies, seminars and many other functions. Its huge backstage area makes the stage area one of the largest in the southern hemisphere and the pick for performing arts companies presenting shows with large sets. It also houses the Silver Jubilee Organ, a remarkable 'hovering' pipe organ built and donated to mark the Silver Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II.
