I am going to see a show at the DreamBIG Children's Festival. The show is called Erth's Prehistoric World.

The show is taking place in the Dunstan Playhouse at the Adelaide Festival Centre. This is the Dunstan Playhouse when there's no one inside



When I see the show, the seats will be full of children like me, excited to see the show! It might be quite loud before the show starts. When the show is about to start, the lights will go down. Erth's Prehistoric World is a theatre show with real people who are wearing costumes and operating puppets.



Some of the puppets are small and some of the puppets are large.

This is an actor standing next to another actor using one of the big puppets.



This is three actors using smaller puppets.

During the show, some people in the audience will be asked to help the actors out on stage.



If I don't want to go on stage, I can tell my teacher and they can make sure I am safe to stay in my seat.

In Erth's Prehistoric World, there will be some loud noises like dinosaur roars. The audience around me might be excited and make some loud noises. These sounds might be overwhelming for me. If I need to cover my ears I can.

If I need to leave the theatre, I can ask my teacher and front of house staff to assist me. The front of house staff have a small torch that they can use to light the stairwell up to the exit.

I might not be able to come back into the theatre, but I can sit outside the theatre and wait for my class to join me.

When the actors are done telling the story, the show is over and the lights will go dark on the stage. Then the actors will come on stage and take a bow. The audience will clap to say thank you to the actors.
