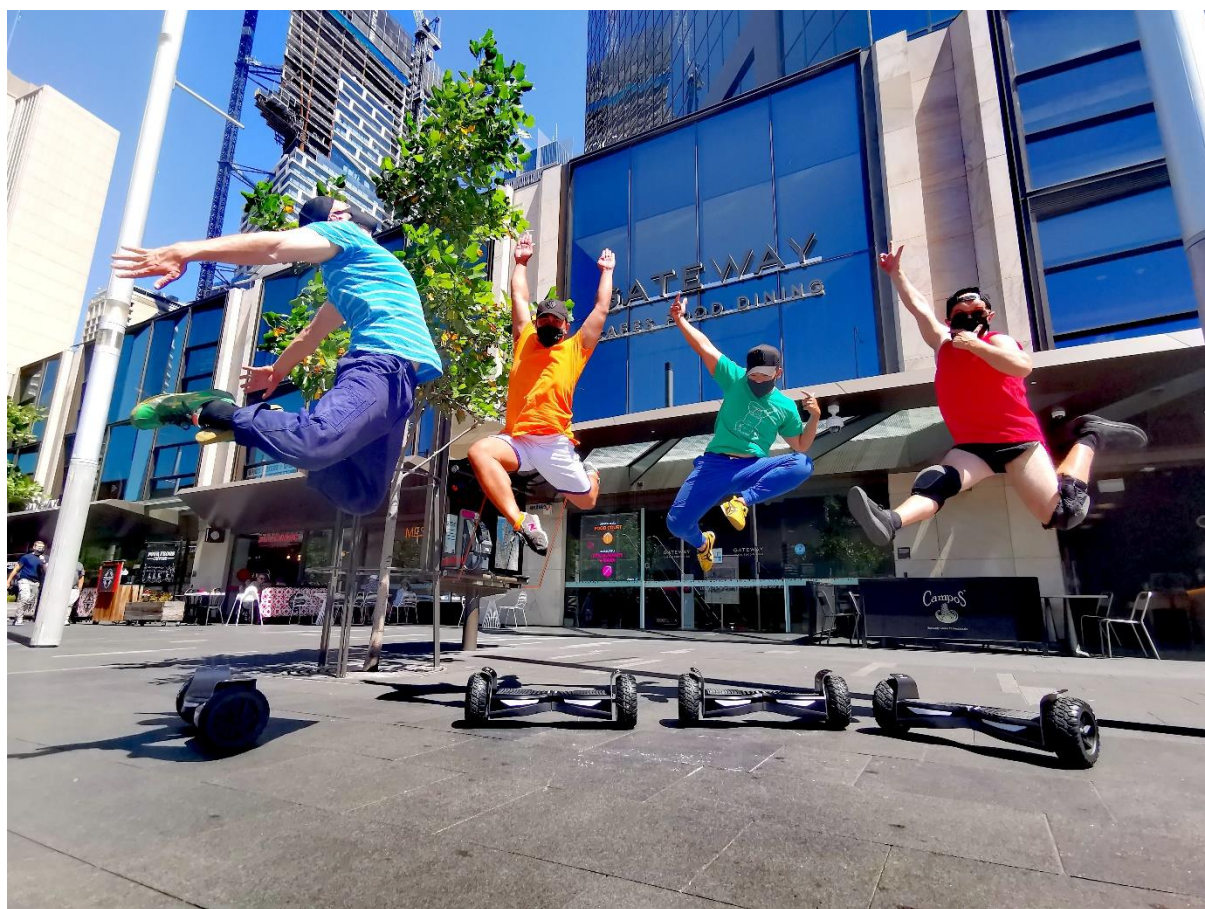


Found Objects

I am coming to see a show at the DreamBIG Children's Festival. The show is called *Found Objects*.

The show is taking place on the Festival Plaza at the Adelaide Festival Centre. The show is happening outside!



When I see the show, there may not be a seat for me to sit on, and I might have to sit on the ground. If I find that hard, I can ask my teacher or the staff there for a chair to sit on.

There might children sitting next to me who I don't know because they're from other schools.

The show is made up of three different performances done by five dancers. The performances are called *Axle*, *Hover*, and *Spin*.

Axle is a duet performance between one of the performers and a remote-control car.



Hover is a performance with five performers dancing on hoverboards.



Spin is a performance with four performers dancing and interacting with a basketball.



When all three performances are done, the five performers will take a bow and leave the performance area. The audience will clap to say thank you to the actors.

When the performance is over, I will wait for instructions from my teacher on what we are doing next.
