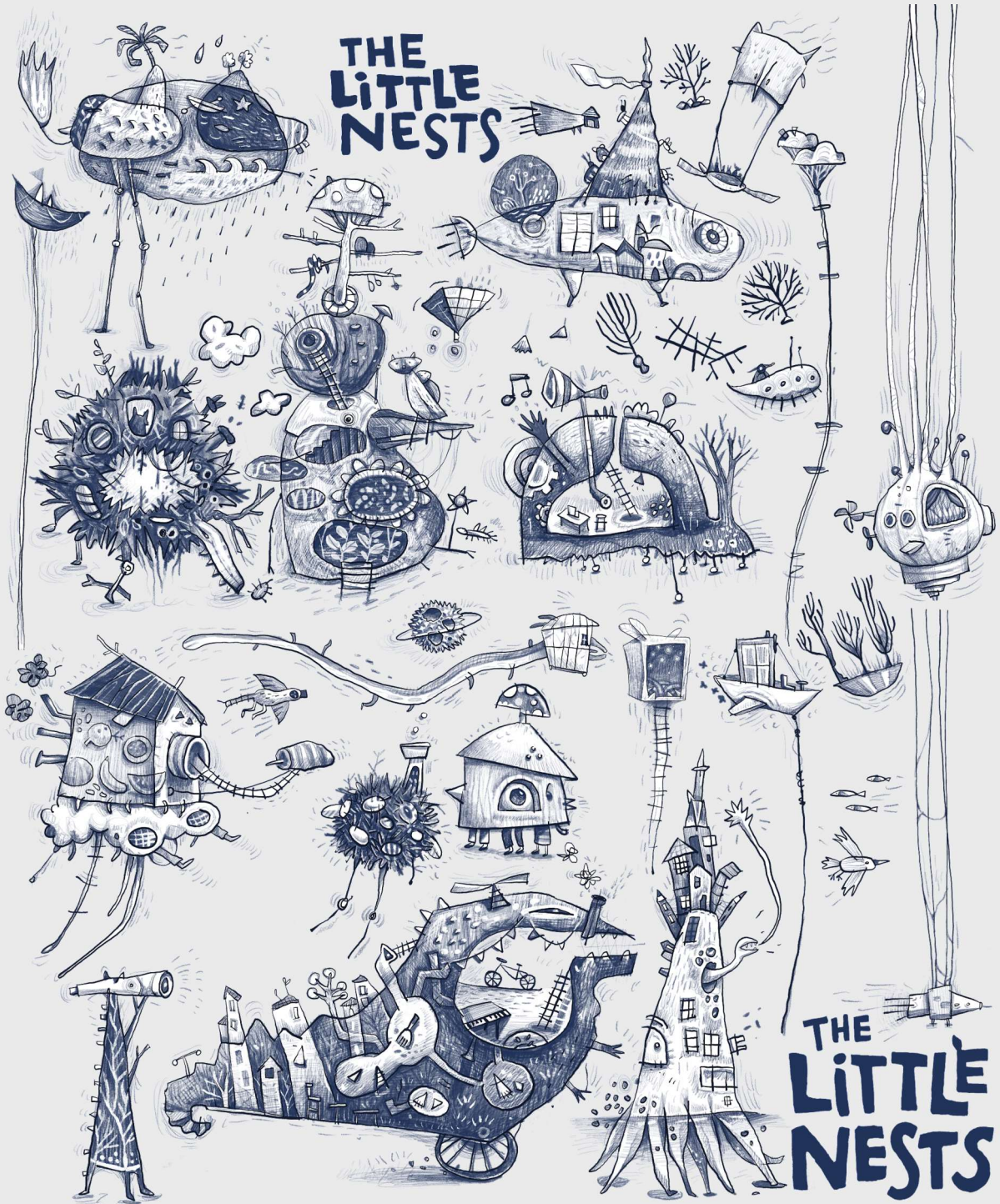


Pre-visit Guide / Visual Story



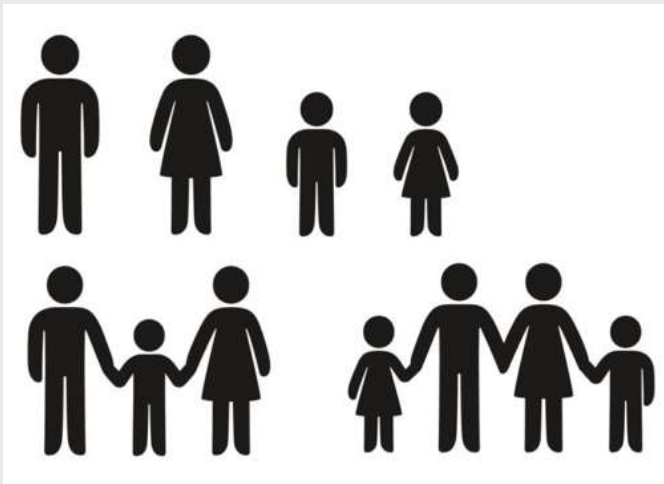
During the visit to “The Little Nests” performance



I will go to Adelaide Festival Centre to be part of an immersive installation and performance called The Little Nests, for OzAsia.

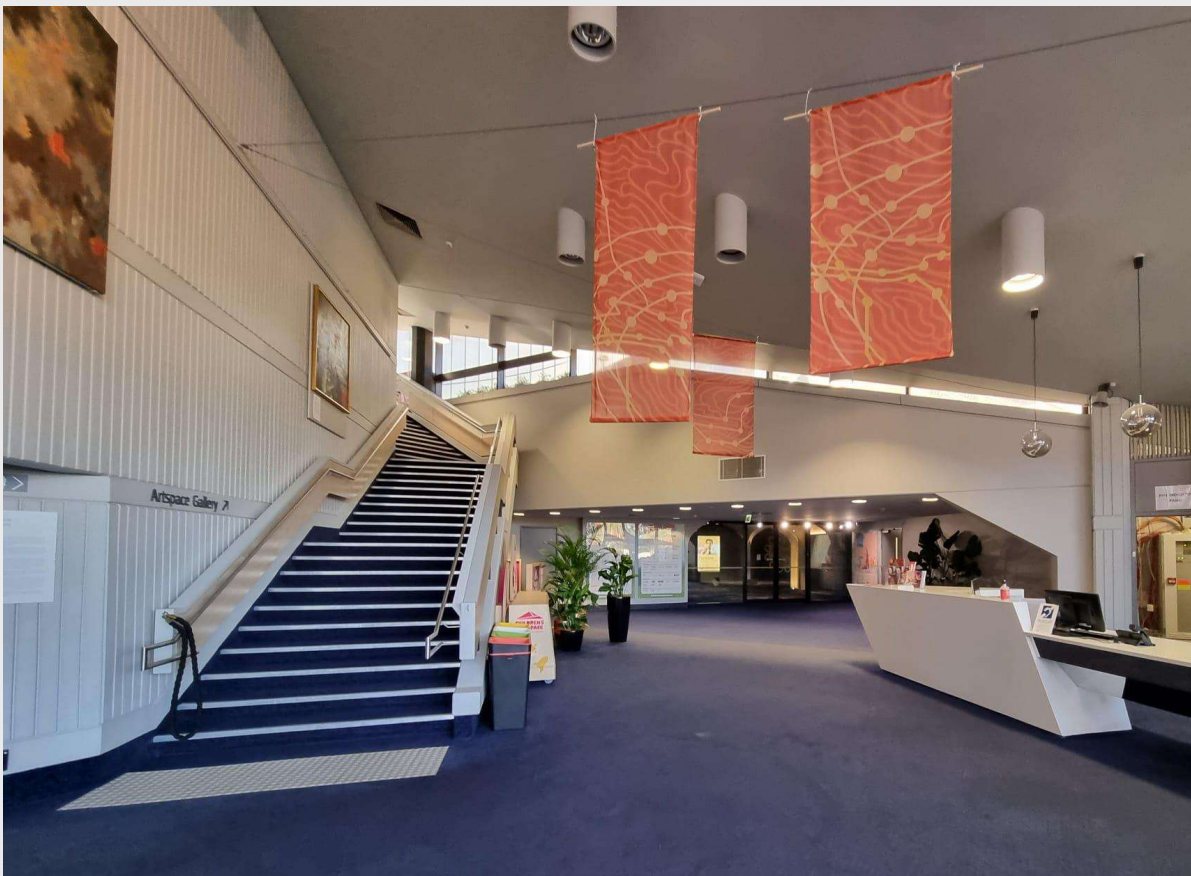


Adelaide Festival Centre is on the bank of the River Torrens.

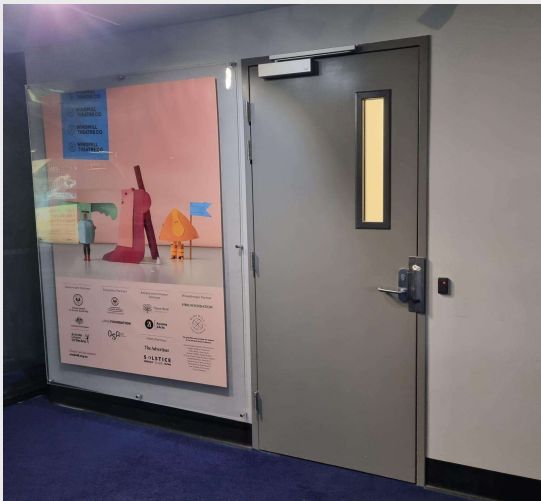


There will be other people going to The Little Nests at ArtPlay too.

We will wait here for a bit, take off our shoes and bags. AFC staff Grace will welcome us and share some house rules. The performers will lead us to the performance space after this.

The Little Nests will take place inside the Drama Centre Rehearsal Room where there will be installations of shadows, puppet creatures, low lighting, live performance and music.



The puppet creatures will be made of Paper, paper clay, masking tape, aluminium rods, nylon fishing line, polyester straps (joints), plastic resin beads (eyes only), finished with acrylic paint.

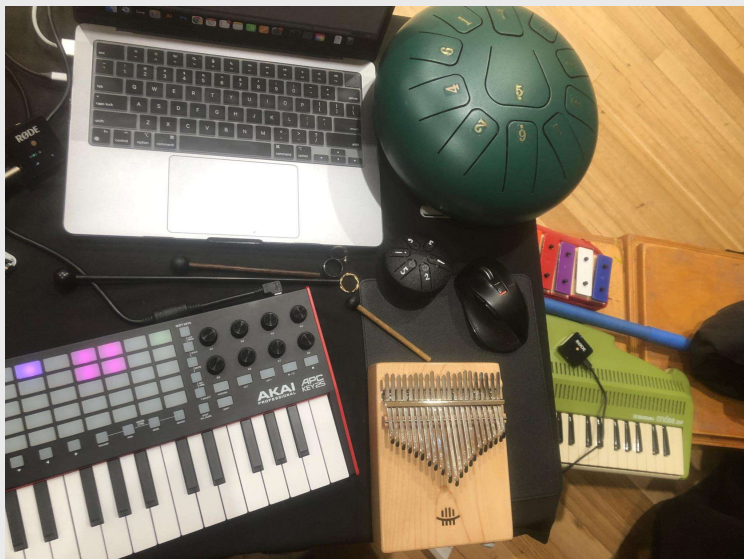


There are musicians sitting at a table who will be playing live music and soundscapes coming from speakers.

During the performance



I will see puppet creatures and performers tell a story without words.



I will see many little nests inside structures for me to find.

I can leave whenever we are ready or want to have a break.

The performance will go about 35 - 40 minutes.

At the end of the sessions, the music will stop, the lights will come on and I will be told that the session has ended. My family/friends and I will leave then.

I can spend time exploring the space and/or make some nests.
